

POEM SUBMISSIONS ARE <u>ACCEPTED</u> FROM <u>APRIL 1ST TO APRIL 3RD</u>

POEMS WILL GO ON DISPLAY FOR VIEWING & CONTEST JUDGING ON APRIL 4TH THROUGH THE 7TH.

Polls close at midnight on the 7th of April.

General Rules:

- 1. All entries will be considered anonymously by the judges.
- 2. Entries will not be returned, so please keep a copy.
- 3. Entrants must complete the entry form to qualify for the contest.
- 4. Submissions must have your entry form stapled to it.
- 5. More than one poem submission is allowed.
- 6. Poems containing profanity, vulgarity or offensive material are automatically disqualified.
- 7. There will be prizes! (Max one prize per person)

Poem Rules:

- 1. Entries can be on any subject.
- 2. Poems must be primarily in English.
- 3. Poems must be the entrant's original work.
- 4. All poems are welcome:
 - a. Physical forms
 - i. Write/Print & attach it to your entry form.
 - b. Digital poems (audio/film/etc.) are welcomed & accepted
 - i. Please create a QR code for your performance (so judges can hear/view it).
 - ii. Then just print out the QR code & attach it to your entry form.

Selection:

Poems are evaluated based on originality, creativity, and artistic quality. Poems containing profanity, vulgarity or offensive material are automatically disqualified.

- Poems will be labeled by letter & go on display (anonymously).
- Through the <u>online form</u> (which will "open" at the end of the submissions period), any library patrons (staff, students, faculty) may vote for their favorite poem!
